

Adios Symbol Rate Limit

The FCC will be voting on and will likely approve a <u>Report and Order</u> that eliminates the symbol rate restriction on HF data transmissions, replacing it with a bandwidth limit of 2.8 kHz. See <u>FCC To Vote on Removing Symbol Rate Restrictions</u>. The symbol rate limit of 300-baud is an obsolete way of limiting the signal bandwidth, created back when the data transmissions were predominately <u>Frequency Shift Keying</u> (FSK).
